Dear Parent/Carer,

You may be aware that there are rising positive COVID cases in the Northwich and surrounding area. In school, we have recently seen an increase in positive COVID cases in a number of year groups across the school.

We have been in contact with the Cheshire West and Chester Public Health team since the start of term and in regular contact since the end of last week.

We have now been advised that we need to implement the following additional control measures from tomorrow (Thursday 14th October).

These additional control measures are:

- **Face coverings** are to be worn inside the building, with the exception of classrooms, unless the student/staff member/visitor is exempt
- The cancellation of the Year 11 Information Evening a film of the presentations will be shared next week
- The **pausing of** any **enrichment clubs,** which includes students from across different year groups
- The pausing of sports fixtures against other schools
- The pausing of group music practice rehearsals, including the band
- The pausing of assemblies with more than one-year group

It is very disappointing that these joyous and rewarding experiences will have to be paused for now. We are hopeful that they will commence again following half-term and will keep all measures under review.

Please remind your child of the importance of:

- **Twice weekly testing**, where consent is given
- Washing hands using warm water and soap, and sanitiser
- Using **tissues** and discarding them in bins
- Following our one-way system
- Entering the building at the start of the day via their **year group entrance** (see attached guidance)



We will continue:

- with increased cleaning
- to **open windows** and doors, wherever possible. Students should wear an additional layer under their jumper
- to have separate entrances for different year groups. Please note, Year 7 students will now enter the building via the Main Reception entrance as from tomorrow (Thursday 14th October)
- to have three food serving locations

In addition, students, staff and visitors should not attend school if they:

- have any of the symptoms of COVID, in which case they should book a PCR test
- have received a positive LFD test result for COVID, in which case they should book a PCR test and continue to isolate until the PCR result in received
- o have received a positive PCR test result for COVID
- o are required to quarantine
- o have been told to isolate by NHS Test and Trace

We will brief students of these additional arrangements tomorrow morning. Please do ensure that your child has a face covering, and a spare, with them from tomorrow until further notice, unless they are exempt.

We share parents/carers and students disappointment that we were required by the Cheshire West and Chester Public Health team to withdraw from the cross country event at very short notice today. As stated above, we hope to return to our hugely successful enrichment activities as soon as possible and thank parents/carers and students for your understanding.

COVID Control Measures

1. Ensure good hygiene for everyone

- o continue to encourage washing of hands with soap and water
- Hand sanitiser continues to be available at various points in the building
- Tissues continue to be available and should be disposed of in hins

2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes

- o regularly touched surfaces will be cleaned more often
- 3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated
 - o windows and doors are kept open wherever possible
- 4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID (see below)

Students must not attend school if they:

- have any of the symptoms of COVID, in which case they should book a PCR test https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test
- 2. have received a **positive LFD test result for COVID**, in which case they should book a PCR test and continue to isolate until the PCR result is received
- 3. have received a positive PCR test result for COVID
- **4.** are required to **quarantine** https://www.gov.uk/guidance/red-amber-and-green-list-rules-for-entering-england
- 5. have been told to isolate by NHS Test and Trace

Close contacts of COVID positive cases no longer need to isolate as long as they:

- are fully vaccinated
- are under 18 and 6 months
- have taken part in or are currently taking part of an approved COVID vaccine trial
- are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

Close contacts will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace and advised to get a PCR test and/or isolate. Unless told to isolate they are able to continue to come to school whilst they wait for the result.

Asymptomatic COVID Testing

- For students/staff where consent has been granted, continue to test twice weekly in the home, following the initial two on-site tests
- Where consent has been granted, students under 12 should be tested by an adult, in the home
- Results (positives and negatives) should be uploaded to https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result
- If a student or member of staff has a positive test with the home testing kits, a PCR test should be booked via https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test. They should not attend school



Face Coverings

- Appropriate* face coverings should be worn by all students, staff and visitors, unless exempt, when in the building apart from classrooms
 - *An appropriate face covering, includes:
 - A mask
 - Masks should only cover the mouth and nose no balaclava type masks
 - Masks must not have any inappropriate content on them
- The government expects and recommends people continue wearing a face covering on public transport.
