French GCSE Topics and Revision 2022

Paper 1 Listening (25%)

This paper will cover topics from all the themes you have covered.

Learn high frequency vocab, negatives and words that can change the sense of a sentence such as sauf (except). When practising independently, try to write in note form then make your answers clear after you have listened to the extract twice.

Paper 2 Speaking Exam (25%)

Students need to practise their answers that they have planned in class. These preparation answers will be similar to what they encounter in their exam. Additionally, students are welcome to drop in with their teacher at a mutually convenient time.

Paper 3 Reading Exam (25%)

Learn high frequency vocab, negatives and words that can change the sense of a sentence such as sauf (except). When practising independently, try to read the extract twice and look out for cognates and synonyms.

Paper 4 Writing Paper (25%)

Learn a bank of versatile high frequency verbs in at least 3 tenses. For example;

Practise your speaking questions at home – but also make sure you can simply answer the question with a sentence and an opinion – as if you forget what you have prepared then you

can still gain points – the secret is having a series of verbs in at least 3 tenses and opinions that you have learnt off by heart for those questions when your mind goes blank.
