





- Science at least 2 GCSEs for all students

#### Science

#### Combined Science (Trilogy)

- Worth 2 GCSEs
- 6 exam papers: 2 Biology, 2 Chemistry and 2 Physics

#### Separate Sciences

- Three separate GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics
- 6 exam papers: 2 Biology, 2 Chemistry and 2 Physics

Both courses are designed to allow students to progress onto A level Sciences



### Separate Science



So all students can study separate Science (if they wish to) we have two pathways

Pathway	Hours per fortnight	Hours per Science GCSE a fortnight	Number of option choices	Total number of qualifications
Express	10 + 1 After school and 1 in Core PE = 12 lessons	4	2	10
Option	10 + 5 in Option block = 15 lessons	5	1	9

Department for Education judges these qualifications to be high quality and of the same standard as GCSE subjects

#### PE Courses



- The PE department offer two PE qualifications
  - GCSE PE (AQA)
  - Cambridge National Sports Studies Level 2 (OCR).
- Both qualifications are judged by the DfE to be high quality and of the same standard
- Note students can only choose one PE course as one of their two options

### 9 GCSEs or Qualifications



- English Language
- English Literature
- Maths
- Science (2 GCSEs)
- French or Spanish
- Geography or History
- Options (2 GCSEs/Vocational Qualifications)

Students who are in the Separate Science express group will achieve 10 GCSEs or qualifications (due to number of option choices)

#### **Vocational Qualifications**



The three vocational courses that are offered to students are Cambridge National Sports Studies Level 2 (OCR)

Pearson BTEC Level 2 Tech Award in Creative Media Production Pearson BTEC Level 2 Tech Award in Digital Information Technology

Some colleges currently only count GCSEs in their entry requirement.

It is important to note, the curriculum the vast majority of students will follow provide them with a minimum of 7 GCSEs. This is currently more than most colleges' entry requirements. Therefore, selecting one or two vocational qualifications still means that all post-16 pathways remain open.





#### French Pathway

Students following the French pathway will study a 'core' of subjects in Years 10 and 11:

- > English (2 GCSEs English Language and English Literature)
- > Mathematics (GCSE)
- > Science (2 or 3 GCSEs for all students)
- > Geography or History (GCSE)
- > EfL (non-exam)
- > Religious Studies
- > French (GCSE)
- > Core PE (non-exam)

Students are placed into a pathway dependent upon the language they have studied

The website will then guide you through each of the steps in the Options process and ask you to select your child's options choices.



Initially students are asked to select a Humanities subject.

Clicking on the link will take you to the curriculum pages for extra information.



Students must decide to study Geography or History as part of their 'core' timetable.


Please note that if students wish to study both Geography and History then they may select the other course in the later option block.


To select the requested option click on the subject name.
