Dear Parents/Carers,

After a busy and successful autumn term, we are looking forward to Christmas and a restful break before we return in 2024. Students have continued to achieve excellence in all sorts of ways which I encourage you to see on the <a href="Sway">Sway</a> and on <a href="YouTube">YouTube</a>. At the end of the letter, we have also included feedback from the parent/carer workshop and an update from the student council.

### **Highlights of Autumn Term 2**

- **ST1** completed by Years 7, 8, 10 and 11. (See 'Guides to Success' for each subject at KS3 and GCSE.)
- Sport: Success in football, rugby, hockey, netball, table tennis and hill walking.
- Activities: Duke of Edinburgh over 70 participants in Year 10; a group of Year 7 and 8 students visited the Children's Adventure Farm; Year 8 have been progressing at Northwich rowing; Year 8 went bowling; CHSL Ski Trip 2024 met with students and parents/carers ahead of their Easter visit to Italy.
- Music: The players visited Hebden Green; played as Davenham lights were switched on; performed at
  the Carol Concert at St Wilfrid's; provided carols at Davenham day-care centre; serenaded the official
  opening of the new block and entertained us all at the Christmas Concert.
- **Primary links**: Maths Challenge was won by Leftwich; we held a hockey festival and basketball tournament and Explorers continued with Year 6.
- Parent/Carer Links: It was great to see lots of people attending Information Evenings for Years 7 and 10, the Parent/carer workshop and supporting the Friends of CHSL. (\*See end of letter 1.)
- **Student Voice**: Junior Leaders showed kindness in their mentoring; Student Ambassadors were articulate and thoughtful when they met SLT and governors. (\*See end of letter 2.)
- **Community**: We supported the Flu vaccination drive; entered the Christmas tree festival; Year 11 organised the Senior Citizens Party; and the community group staffed the pre-loved uniform shop.
- Foundation: The new building was officially opened and The Macclesfield Academy joined SJBF.
