SKI CLOTHING AND ACCESSORIES

- ✓ Ski socks 3 pairs min.
- Base layers (not cotton)
- Mid layers
- Ski jacket and ski trousers
- Ski gloves or mittens

- Ski goggles and sunglasses
- Ski helmet
- Sun cream and lip salve
- ✓ Après-ski wear comfy and warm





Hand luggage - A SMALL bag

- No sharp instruments
- Small pillow and blanket
- Ski Jacket & Ski Socks
- Clean top
- Deodorant/toothbrush and toothpaste
- Face wipes
- Water and some snacks
- Euros and British Pounds to buy food and drinks
- IPad/phone and chargers
- Personal entertainment devices. students are responsible for these throughout the trip. It is strongly advised all items are named.
- NAMED DVD's prior to the day
- Medication
- Please ensure that travel sickness pills are taken in good time for the journey

- DVD players, Mobile
 Phones, iPads and Cameras may be taken, but will be the student's own responsibility.
- The CHSL staff or Interski will not accept any responsibility if they are lost or damaged.
- We recommend that expensive items are either not taken or insured through your own household policy.
- *Remember a European adapter plug will be needed to charge phones or power electrical items. A 4socket extension lead per room is useful too.

Monitored from September 2023 to the date we travel. Mrs Towers and Mrs Berry consulted.

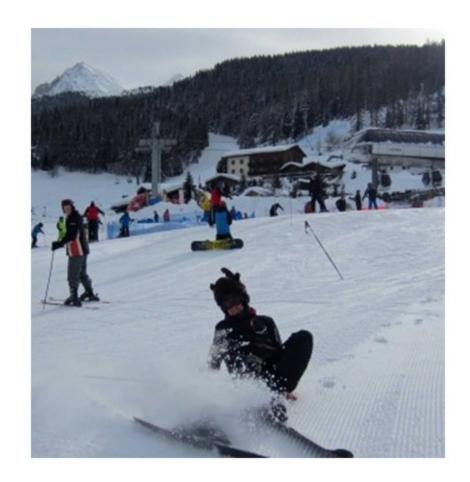
