


Supporting Success in Year 11

Your exams will used to generate a projected grade which is where teachers predict what you will achieve at the end of Year 11 *if* you continue work as you are working.




You will also be issued with a working at grade in Year 11 at both ST1 and ST2

COUNTY ST Exams will decide the Appropriate Tier

- Maths, Science & MFL are tiered.
 - Foundation (1-5) and Higher (4-9)
 - Students must be entered for the correct tier.
 - The tier that you will be entered for will be dependent on the results from **both** ST1 and ST2.

"We recommend that students who are predicted to achieve a grade 4-4 or 5-4 in Combined Science, or a 4 in MFL, should be entered for the foundation tier." **Ofqual**




