We are looking forward to **Year 11 Mock Results** on **Friday 21**st **November**. Students will collect their results at 3pm in the School Gym. This experience will give students a sense of what it will feel like when they receive their GCSE results in the Summer, which we will talk to them about in assembly next week.

Members of staff will be available during this time to talk to students about how they feel about the results received and to provide support if needed. Students will be allowed to **leave the school site from approximately 3:10pm**, which is a slightly earlier finish for students, so that they can discuss the results with you.

We look forward to lots of students celebrating their success. However, if any students are disappointed with their results, please be assured that the process is designed so that there is enough time for students to make improvements before the GCSEs.

As we move towards the exams, the key focus to ensure that students will make progress is by ensuring that they **attend** all lessons. They will receive quality first teaching and structured revision from expert teachers. Time will be allocated in lessons for students to look at gaps in their knowledge and skills and to identify areas for improvement moving forwards.

In addition, there are intervention slots available throughout the week, across a range of subjects, which offer extra support with revision and exam preparation. Students are aware of when these revision sessions are, but please do talk to them about attending when they can. A full report will be provided in the week beginning 1st December.
