

Naples

Purpose of the trip

- ▶ Act as an enrichment trip for the students Geography GCSE. A chance to see a real volcanic environment and the effects of this on the landscape, people and economy of the area.

Naples Staffing

- ▶ Mr Burton – Trip leader, First aider
- ▶ Mrs Wells
- ▶ Mr Ralph

- ▶ Each member of staff will be assigned 11 students to directly supervise and register at regular intervals during the trip and outings.
- ▶ The students will be asked to provide their personal mobile phone numbers prior to the trip so that we have the ability to contact students directly and quickly should the need arise.
- ▶ Students will be informed of their designated staff member prior to departure.

Passports and GHICs

- ▶ Students are responsible for bringing their passports and GHIC cards to the airport with them.
- ▶ Once at the hotel we will ask the hotel to store the passports in the hotel safe until our departure.
- ▶ GHICs we will ask students to give to their member of staff to look after so that if they are needed we have them to hand

- ▶ If your student does not have a GHIC card – please apply for one as soon as possible

Naples Insurance

- ▶ Students on this visit are insured but please note that their mobile phones, iPads and cameras, etc are **not** covered under this policy. Should you require cover for such items, please organise this via your own policy.

Travel arrangements

- ▶ 28/3/26 Manchester airport to Ciampino airport
- ▶ Ryanair FR 3206, terminal 3
- ▶ **Please arrive at the airport at 3 hours prior to departure (5:25am)**
- ▶ Flight departs at 08:25

Wear your trip hoodie - There will be a student meeting to discuss which colour we should choose and for students to try sizes, add names/nicknames

Travel arrangements - baggage

- ▶ Students are solely responsible for carrying and looking after their own luggage at all times. Students are advised to travel as lightly as possible - remember we are only staying for 5 days in shared rooms
- ▶ You may bring two bags as follows:
 - ▶ 20kg checked-in per passenger.
 - ▶ plus one small personal bag which can be brought on board, such as a **handbag or laptop bag (40cm x 30 x 20 cm.), which must fit under the seat in front of you.**

- ▶ **If under 100ml and in a transparent re-sealable plastic bag,** passengers are permitted to take liquids, gels and pastes through security separately from their hand baggage. It is best to prepare your liquid bag - no larger than 20cm x 20cm and not exceeding one litre - before arrival at Manchester Airport



Items to pack

- Jeans / trousers /shorts – don't need lots of each, one of each is sufficient
 - Wear your trip hoodie to the Airport
 - Tops / T-shirts
 - Underwear
 - Socks
 - Footwear: sensible shoes for walking each day and a spare set for evenings
 - Warm waterproof coat for Mount Vesuvius and Naples Underground trips
 - Nightwear
 - Travel-sized toiletries – shampoo, shower gel, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant
- Travel-sized sunscreen and/or money to buy some on arrival in Sorrento
- Refillable** water bottle
 - Cap or sun hat
 - Adapters/phone chargers for Italian plugs
 - Money – euros

Behaviour

- ▶ Students will be expected to behave sensibly throughout the visit. As they are representing the school, we expect a very high standard of behaviour.
- ▶ If a student's behaviour falls below expectations, then sanctions will be imposed. If there is a serious breach, then parents will be asked to come to Naples to escort the student home.
- ▶ Students will be given time to explore designated areas without direct staff supervision. When this is the case they must stay in the groups that they are designated. Abide by the boundary and behaviour rules given.
- ▶ Strictly no alcohol is to be purchased or drunk by students when on the trip.

Naples Accommodation

- ▶ **Hotel Albatross, Piano Di Sorrento**
- ▶ **Half board**
- ▶ Via Madonna di Roselle, 54,
80063 Piano di Sorrento, Italy



Students are to not use the room balconies or the pool

- ▶ We are half-board during our visit. Students will need some money for extra drinks and snacks.
- ▶ **Towels will be provided by the hotel.**
- ▶ On arrival, check your room immediately and report any damage left by previous occupants.
- ▶ The Hotel will have its own rules. Make sure you read and obey them.
- ▶ **SMOKING AND DRINKING OF ALCOHOL IS FORBIDDEN** and there is to be no noise in sleeping areas after 11.00pm
- ▶ **Students are not permitted to go in others bedrooms after the “in rooms“ time**
- ▶ To reduce the risk of any room theft, make sure valuables are out of sight or locked away in your suitcase.
- ▶ Treat your room with care and keep it tidy. It will be inspected daily and damage must be paid for on the spot. All students within a room will be responsible for any damage.

Itinerary – Saturday 28th March 2026

05:25hrs Check in at **Manchester International Airport, Terminal 3** for **RYANAIR Flight Number FR 3206**.

We recommend that the group purchase lunch items once through passport control at Manchester airport.

08:25hrs **Flight departs.**

12:20hrs Arrive at **Ciampino Airport** (local time).

Group will be met by the **city rep**

13:20hrs Coach transfer

14:20hrs Estimated arrival at the coach drop off point in Rome, group will then continue on foot to the **Colosseum**.

14:50hrs Arrival at the **Colosseum**.
Group to meet their guide. Headset Required.

Itinerary – Saturday 28th March 2026

- 15:10hrs** Group to start guided tour,
- 17:10hrs** Visit ends, group to make their way back to the coach meeting point.
- 17:40hrs** Group to re-join the coach and depart for **Bay of Naples**.
- 21:40hrs** Anticipated arrival at hotel Albatross.
- 22:00hrs** Cold evening meal will be served at the hotel.
- Evening** Group to get settled into their rooms.

Itinerary – Sunday 29th March

- ▶ **AM: Naples underground tour**
- ▶ **Naples underground tour - exploring the caves of Naples underground**

- ▶ **PM: Pompeii**
- ▶ **Tour of Pompeii - can be *very* warm so bring suncream, plan for a lot of walking - get to see the casts of people when they were overwhelmed by Pompeii**

- ▶ **After evening meal: Walk down to the bay area of Piano Di Sorrento - gelato if the ice cream bar is open**

Itinerary – Monday 30th

March

- ▶ **AM:**
- ▶ Isle of Capri - boat trip to the Isle of Capri, all students need to sit together on the boat.
- ▶ We will either get the funicular railway (depends on how busy it is) or walk to the top of the town where the shops and historical areas are - students will have independent time to explore together in their groups - imagine Monaco but in Italy
- ▶ **After evening meal: Naples Gelato making experience and walk around Sorrento town centre including some independent time in groups**

Itinerary – Tuesday 31st March

- ▶ **AM - Mount Vesuvius**
- ▶ Strong and sensible footwear is essential as the walk to the crater is steep with loose gravel. Warm clothing is essential as it can be very cold at the summit (bring your trip hoody and/or coat). The crater may be closed, depending on weather conditions.

- ▶ **PM - Herculaneum**
- ▶ A really well preserved town that has been excavated

- ▶ **Evening - Mrs Wells ' quiz! Then pack up your bags and get ready for morning check-out**



Naples

Itinerary – Wednesday 1st April 2026

- ▶ Check-out of the hotel
- ▶ Flight departs 13:15 local time
- ▶ Flight arrives 15:30 Manchester airport, **Terminal 2**



Naples Meals

- ▶ Full continental breakfast is provided by the hotel
- ▶ Full evening meal is provided by the hotel
- ▶ Students are recommended to bring approx. **€20-€25 per day** to purchase lunch
- ▶ Students may wish to bring extra spending money for souvenirs etc.



Naples Safety

- ▶ The Academy has produced an extensive Risk Assessment for the trip, but the success of this relies on students fulfilling their obligations in the Code of Conduct.
- ▶ The most important expectation placed on the students is that they do not separate from their group and follow instructions from members of staff.
- ▶ The Hotel will have its own rules. Make sure you read and obey them.
- ▶ Students must stay in their rooms after lights out in the evening – with the doors locked.
- ▶ **SMOKING AND DRINKING OF ALCOHOL IS FORBIDDEN** and there is to be no noise in sleeping areas after 11.00pm
- ▶ **Students are not permitted to go in others bedrooms after the “in rooms “ time**
- ▶ Students **must wear seatbelts** at all times and they must ensure they are sensible on the various journeys.

Naples Safety

- ▶ Students will be responsible for their own valuables, including mobile phones, iPads, cameras etc. Please check with your household/travel insurance if you require extra cover. **PLEASE NO SPEAKERS.**
- ▶ All money brought on the trip will be the responsibility of the student. Students are advised to bring €20- €25 in Euros per day.
- ▶ **Emergency during the visit** - students will be told of the emergency procedures prior to departure. Trip Organisers have emergency contact numbers for all parents/carers and will telephone immediately, should the need arise.
