Dear Parent/Carer,

As you are aware, over half term we have moved to a new information system called **Arbor** which replaced Synergy. We are currently working to get the system fully up and running. Unfortunately, the booking system will not be working fully in time for the Year 11 in-person Progress Evening on Thursday 12th March. Therefore, we plan to use a paper-based booking system.

Booking your in-person appointment(s) – What you need to do now

Students will be given a booking sheet on Monday 2nd March during form time, which they will take to their subject teachers to book appointments for parents evening. ***Please ensure that you make your child aware of the time slots that you are able to attend over the weekend, prior to them booking slots with teachers from Monday 2nd March.*** Please note that the in-person appointments will be five minutes long, in order that all requests can be accommodated. Should you need additional time, this can be arranged with the teacher. In the unlikely event that you find that it is not possible to make an appointment to see a particular teacher, then please contact admin@leftwichhigh.com and we will be in touch.

The evening, which will run from 4.00pm to 7.00pm, will give you the opportunity to meet your child's teachers **at school** and to discuss progress in their subjects at a very important stage in this final year.



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We feel that through meeting in-person, subject teachers can outline what progress has been made at ST1 and ST2, explain how well your child is working and identify the areas that need to be focused upon to be successful in the summer. Teachers will outline the curriculum and revision focuses for the rest of the year and provide revision resources so that students can prepare effectively in school and can be supported at home. Additional intervention is available in all subjects and teachers may encourage your child to attend sessions in the run-in to the exams. Students are expected to attend the evening with a parent/carer.

Mock results day

There will be a **Mock Results Day** on Friday 6th March 2026 from 3:00pm when predicted grades will be shared with students, based upon performance in ST2. ***Students will be allowed to leave school after the collection of their results.*** Tier of entry will be discussed with students in Maths, Science and MFL. **Full reports** will be issued week commencing Monday 9th March. We intend for this process to keep you fully informed about your child's progress and enable you to support them effectively during this time.
