Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to invite you and your child to our **in-person** Year 9 Progress Evening on **Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2026**. The evening, which will run from 4.00pm to 7.00pm, will give you the opportunity to meet your child's teachers **in school** and to discuss progress in their subjects so far in Year 9.

In addition to appointments for core subjects that your child will study from September (English, Maths, Science, Geography, History, French, Spanish) **we would only expect appointments to be made in other subjects that your child will be choosing as an Option subject**. You may still make appointments in other subjects if you wish.

At the **In-person** Progress Evening, Subject teachers will outline what progress has been made at ST1, how well your child is working and what the areas are that they need to focus upon to be successful moving forward.
