81% of students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at Grade C or above (including GCSEs in English Language and Maths).

84% of Year 11 students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at Grade C or above.

85% achieved Grade C or above in both English Language and Maths.

46% achieved the 'English Baccalaureate' (Grade C or above in English Language, Maths, Science, a Humanities subject and a Modern Language).

88% of Year 11 achieved GCSE A* - C in English Language, with 24% achieving A* or A grades.

92% of Year 11 achieved GCSE A* - C in Maths, with 37% achieving A* or A grades.

8% of Year 11 achieved at least 10 A* or A grades.

13% of Year 11 achieved at least 8 A* or A grades.

33% of Year 11 achieved at least 4 A* or A grades.

64% of Year 11 achieved at least one A* or A grade.

89% of students made 3 or more 'Levels of progress' from KS2 English National Curriculum Tests to GCSE English Language (NB 2013 national figure 69%). Indeed 40% made or 4 or more 'Levels of progress' (NB 2013 national 30%).

87% of students made 3 or more 'Levels of progress' from KS2 Maths National Curriculum Tests to GCSE Maths (NB 2013 national figure 70%). Indeed 48% made or 4 or more 'Levels of progress' (NB 2013 national 32%).
